Tasting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The cuvée Prestige of Château Tayet is attractive and delicate and far superior to the average standard of a Bordeaux Supérieur, this thanks to its rich colour, its intense and complex nose but especially its full-bodied taste with lots of texture and ripe tannins.
